

In Term Swimming Lessons 2014 – Years PP-Year 5

Parent/Carer Information

Please read the following details carefully and contact the School Office on 9405 4007 if you require any further information.

- **Venue**
 - The Joondalup Arena heated indoor pool.
- **Dates**
 - The lessons will be from **Monday 8 December to Wednesday 17 December [8 days]** inclusive.
- **Costs**
 - The only cost for the eight lessons is the hire of the bus from Belridge Bus Charter. This has been set at \$33.00 on a cost recovery basis. No GST is charged.
 - The cost includes bus and pool entry. [An entry fee of \$2 is charged for spectators].
 - There is no charge for the swimming tuition as this is provided by the Department of Education.
 - The high cost of diesel fuel is a factor in the cost.
- **Clothing**
 - Students will change into their bathers at school. Please provide a named plastic bag so that they can change for the return to school. All clothing should be named.
 - Lost property (and we usually have quite a lot) will be returned to school and placed outside the medical room in the Atrium.
 - Swimming goggles are permitted.
- **Long Hair**
 - Students with long hair are requested to have it tied back before arriving at the lessons. It is not appropriate to wear jewellery or to bring valuables to swimming lessons.
- **Refunds**
 - As the cost of the bus is calculated over the whole group of students, a refund cannot be made for non attendance.
 - However, if a lesson is missed, the pool entry can be refunded. This would be done on written application once the lessons have concluded.
- **Enrolments**
 - Please complete the attached enrolment form in every detail and return it to class teachers in a suitably marked envelope by **Friday 5 December** with the appropriate payment. All cheques should be made payable to EDGEWATER PRIMARY SCHOOL and marked NOT NEGOTIABLE.

 - Please accurately complete the stage going for and the final statement on medical conditions if appropriate.
 - Wherever possible, and in consultation with parents and carers, students who can show evidence of having attempted the same stage three times will be given additional assistance to help them progress to the next stage.
- If your child has been observed, or is otherwise known to be subject to any form of medical condition involving periodic loss of consciousness (eg diabetes/epilepsy), please state this on the enrolment form and discuss the matter with the office urgently.
