Swimming lessons form an integral part of our Physical Education programme and are conducted by fully-trained Department of Education swimming teachers. Attendance at these lessons is as important as any class lessons.

Venue	HBF Joondalup Arena heated indoor pool.
Dates	Monday 19 November to Friday 30 November inclusive.
Costs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No charge for actual lessons. Transport in seat-belted bus and pool entry - \$47.50 (GST free). Spectators - \$2.60.
Clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please provide a named plastic bag. All clothing, including goggles and towels, should be named. Lost property will be returned to school and placed on the seats outside the library. Swimming goggles are permitted.
Long Hair/Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students with long hair are requested to have it tied back before arriving at the lessons. It is not appropriate to wear jewellery or to bring valuables to swimming lessons.
Refunds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The cost of the bus is calculated over the whole group of students attending. Refunds cannot be made for non-attendance. If a lesson is missed, the pool entry can be refunded at the end of the programme following a written request to Kathy Dean, our Manager of Corporate Services.
Enrolments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete the attached enrolment form in every detail and return it to class teachers in a suitably marked envelope by Friday 9 November with the payment of \$47.50. If paying online please email kathy.dean@education.wa.edu.au to confirm payment. Accurately complete the stage going for and the final statement on medical conditions if appropriate. Wherever possible, and in consultation with parents and carers, students who can show evidence of having attempted the same stage <u>three</u> times will be given additional assistance to help them progress to the next stage.
