Year 6 Camp – 2021

Year 6 students (2021) will be participating in a 4 day camp at Nanga Bush Camp in Dwellingup. The following provides you with some preliminary details in preparation for next year.

The Nanga Bush Camp is an annual event for our Year 6 students. The camp is situated on the banks of the Murray River on 10 hectares of forest. Children will be accommodated in 'Currawong Lodge' a large bunkhouse style building that consists of sleeping areas, a kitchen, ablution facilities, communal dining area and large recreation hall.

Activities planned for the camp include team building, bushcraft, flat water rafting, flying fox, raft building and games. The students are divided into groups so as to maximize participation. Each group is under the direction of a qualified instructor, and a school staff member.

Camp Dates:	Tuesday 9 to Friday 12 March (including travel).
Location:	Nanga Bush Camp, Nanga Brook, Dwellingup.
Transport:	Coaches with seatbelts.
Travel Time:	Approximately 1½ hours (110 kms).
Cost:	\$420 - includes transport. This is an approximate cost and will be finalised early in 2021.
Other Costs:	Nil
Meals:	All meals and snacks are provided while at the camp site. From lunch on Tuesday to lunch on Friday.
Accommodation:	Dormitory double bunk beds.
Adult Supervision:	Qualified camp staff coordinate activities while on site and students are also accompanied by Edgewater school staff.
In Case of Accident or Illness:	Parents will be contacted, or in an emergency, hospital treatment will be sought.

Payment can be made at any time and we are happy to accept instalments. Please contact our Manager of Corporate Services, Kathy Dean, to organise this arrangement. Payments can be made online or by cash in the school office. We would like all Year 6 students to attend the camp.
