



2026 Contribution and Charges Schedule - Kindergarten to Year 6

Dear Parents/Carers,

School Contribution and Charges

The Edgewater Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule for Contributions and Charges for 2026. The schedule is divided into 4 sections and will allow you to calculate all the costs that you may incur throughout the year.

SECTION 1: CONTRIBUTION

The total amount of **contribution** parents and carers are being asked to pay is **\$60 per child**, which is within the \$60 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

Monies collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the 8 Curriculum Learning Areas. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of the teaching and learning program will be maximized when each family makes their contribution.

The contributions can be paid using the following options:

- A single payment with the Personal Items List (booklist) – *the preferred supplier, Campion, sends the contributions to the school with a full list of student names (preferred option)*
- A single payment using the Online Payment System – see School Bank Details
- A single EFTPOS payment through the school's front office

SECTION 2: CHARGES FOR EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS

A breakdown of **estimated charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, swimming and other activities is tabled below.

**** Primary Extension & Challenge program offers a range of courses for selected students that vary in cost from \$30-\$300 per year.**

Not all students will be registered for all programs, and it is anticipated that there will be one whole-school incursion a term. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity, and the amounts indicated on the schedule represent the **MAXIMUM** charged for planned activities in 2026.

These can be paid using the following options:

- **Compass Pay** (preferred method)
- A single EFTPOS payment through the school's front office

SECTION 3A: ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE IN THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The charge for **personal use items** will vary from student to student. Items are on the Personal Items List (booklist) for each year level which is distributed in Term 4 – with copies on the school website. See the table for the total cost per year level if **all** items are purchased and note that the School Board has capped the cost at \$225.00. Please remember that some items may need to be replaced throughout the year.

Campion has been engaged as the preferred supplier; however, parents and carers may choose to use any supplier. All Campion orders **must be made using their online ordering system**. Details are with the Personal Items List and there is a link on the school website.

The above are the maximum personal item order costs. Should the items be in good working order from the previous year they do not need to be purchased again. These items may include scissors, calculators, library bag and headsets.

From time to time the school supports fundraising for the Parents and Citizens' Association (P&C) and other charity organizations. These costs are optional.

SECTION 4: VOLUNTARY APPROVED FUNDS

For 2026, the P&C Contribution has been set at **\$50 per family**.

This can be paid using the following options:

- **A single payment with the Personal Items List Order (booklist)** – *Campion send the contributions to the P&C with a full list of student names (preferred option).*
- A single EFTPOS payment through the school's front office.
