

SCHOOL DRESS POLICY

Uniform Requirements

The school has a student dress code in place which has been developed following consultation with parents, teachers and students. This code is strongly supported by the School Board and the P&C Association.

ALL STUDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO WEAR FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM EACH DAY

When all students are in full uniform:

- It fosters pride in our school, a sense of belonging and a strong identification with the school.
- It contributes to the safety and security of students through easy identification.
- It assists in building school tone and team spirit.

School uniform requirements for all students K-6

Daily Wear

- Royal blue & gold polo shirt
- Royal blue shorts (mid-leg length, must be visible)
- Royal blue skorts (mid-leg length, must be visible)
- Royal blue skirts (mid-leg length, must be visible)
- Blue checked dress
- Royal blue & gold jacket
- Royal blue tracksuit pants or jazz pants.
- Bucket hat in royal blue for all outdoor activities including recess and lunch breaks
- Graduation T-shirt (Year 6 only)
- Graduation Jacket (Year 6 only)
- Royal blue or gold cultural headwear

Sports Days & PE Lesson Days

- T-shirt or polo shirt in faction colour
- Royal blue shorts
- Royal blue skorts
- Bucket hat in royal blue

Please Note

- Appropriate closed in footwear must be worn at all times-no thongs, slip-ons, high heeled footwear, Ugg boots or Crocs.
- Joggers/runners must be securely laced and tied.
- Shoulder length hair or longer to be tied back-head bands or clips to be in school colours or natural hair colour.
- No makeup, nail polish, jewellery (except for a watch, ear studs or sleepers).
- Royal blue tights may be worn under dress or skorts/skirts (winter only).
- Smart watches must always be on school mode.
