- Students will be allowed to colour their hair, wear face paint and bring along mascots and streamers. Please apply hair colour and face paint at home only.

#### **Bay Times**

All students are required to be in their faction bay and with their classes throughout the day. Please do not encourage your child/children to leave their bay or activities as this can cause problems for supervising teachers. There will be one scheduled break – lunch time - where children can join with their parents.

#### **Seating Arrangements**

Supporters can set up their blankets, chairs etc on the bank between the oval and the fitness track, on the high bank leading to the tennis courts, and in front of the nature playground beside the track and up to the starting line. Please do not set up in the faction bays, behind the faction bays, behind the finishing line or near the scorer's tent and presentation area. Parents are welcome to walk with their children's group during tabloid games.

#### Canteen

While the students can enjoy a sausage sizzle lunch pre-ordered from the canteen (and delivered down to their faction tents at lunchtime), parents and spectators will be looked after too! A sausage sizzle will be on offer to spectators this year, together with soft drinks, delicious homemade baked goods and ice cream. A coffee van will be on site also. The canteen is always looking for parent volunteers. If you can assist on the day, kindly pop up to the refreshment tent to offer your help. You won't miss your child's events!

#### **Early Release of Students**

The faction carnival is a whole school event that every student is expected to participate in from beginning to end, as it is a school day. Duty of care for students remains with the faction teachers and your child's classroom teacher throughout the day. Students will be required to return to their classroom at the end of the carnival to be dismissed and collect their bags. If a parent needs to take their child from the oval early for a medical reason or similar, they will need to sign them out at the scorer's tent.

#### **Age Group Champions**

Age group champions will be decided by an individual's cumulative score from the following events: Cross Country, 400m/800m, Sprint Race, Long Throw, Long Jump. Winners will be announced at Assembly on the following Friday.

#### **Parent Involvement:**

The Faction Athletics Carnival is a community event, which means we love having the involvement of parents and carers. This year, parents will be invited to participate in: 75m Sprint Race, Junior Parents Passball (teams of 8), Senior Parents Passball (teams of 8), Sack Races, Tug-o-war and 75m Baton Relay (Teams of 4).

In the interests of safety for all concerned, please ensure you wear appropriate footwear and have the required fitness to participate in your chosen events. Don't forget to come in your faction colours to support students!

**Year 6 parents/carers** are asked to please help with the setting up and packing down of the faction tents on Friday 26 August. Set up will be at 7am. Pack down will be at 2:40pm.
