Welcome back to all our Edgewater PS students and their families. New students - have you heard about our Canteen? Come and check us out. We're located in the undercover area and are open five days a week from 8.15am to 1.45pm for counter sales and PRE-ORDERED lunches. Orders can be placed in person before school or online through our ordering system -

QuickClig.com.au. Online orders close off at 9am on the day of the order, but can be placed at any time before the cut off date and time. Menus are available from the canteen or can be viewed on the school website.



Our canteen strives to provide healthy meals and snacks to students and we are very proud of the fact that most of our menu items are classified as green according to the food traffic light system. All of our tray meals (lasagne, macaroni and cheese, spaghetti bolognaise, butter chicken, bangers and mash and rainbow risotto) are freshly prepared in the canteen and are chock full of hidden vegetables. Gluten free options are available too.

Parents and carers - I'm always looking for assistance in the canteen. If you would like to help out for an hour, a morning or a day, please come and see me or call me on 0436 919 883. Volunteers will not only be provided with a cuppa and something to eat, but will also receive \$5 off their child's lunch on the day that they work.

Welcome back to school! What a start we have had. It is so exciting to see the children back at school, their smiling faces are such a joy to see.


Welcome to all of our new families. I look forward to meeting you all this year. You have joined a wonderful school community.
